

A Noninvasive Treatment for Facial Lines and Wrinkles

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What is BOTOX?

BOTOX cosmetic is a purified, natural protein derived from the bacterium *Clostridium* botulinum.

BOTOX works by blocking acetylcholine impulses that trigger hyperactive muscle contractions that cause wrinkles and other medical conditions.

BOTOX is made by Allergan, Inc., a company with over 15 years of successful clinical experience in treating multiple conditions.

What Is BOTOX Used For?

BOTOX has a broad range of medical indications including the treatment of facial wrinkles, headaches, hyperhidroisis (excess sweating), muscle spasticity and cerebral palsy.

What Kind of Facial Wrinkles Can BOTOX Treat?

BOTOX is used to treat wrinkles above and around the eyes. It can be an effective treatment for crows feet, frown lines in between the eyes and "worry lines" of the forehead.

Who Cannot Receive BOTOX Treatments?

Patients who are pregnant, nursing, have a neuromuscular disease, bleeding disorder or other medical condition that may make them immuno-comprimised cannot have BOTOX injections. The initial consultation with your provider will determine if you are an appropriate candidate for BOTOX treatments*.

What are the Possible Side Effects of BOTOX treatments?

Some patients experience mild swelling or bruising at the site of injection. Rare complications include infection, dry or watery eyes, asymmetrical results and a droopy eyelid.

If any of these complications do occur, they will be temporary.

How Much Does BOTOX Cost?

The current rate for treatment is \$250.00 per treatment area or 2or more areas for \$500.00

One treatment area consists of:

One pair of crow's feet

OR

The frown lines between the eyes

OR

Worry lines of the forehead

How Should I Prepare for a BOTOX Treatment?

Do not take any Aspirin or NSAIDS (Ibuprofen, Advil, Aleve) for 48 hours prior to your treatment. These may cause excessive bleeding at the injection sites.

What is the Recovery Time?

There is NO recovery time after BOTOX treatment. You may resume your regular activities immediately but are advised not to lie down for 4 hours after treatment.
